Fabric & Cutting Chart

SB20413-760	1 yard	Quilt center Trim panel to measure 30 ½" x 40 ½", centering design.
SB20415-760	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20415-815	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (10) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20105-100	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20051-100	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20171-845	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20197-310	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (10) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.

SB20103-430	1/8 yard	Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.
SB20053-280	1/2 yard	 a. Pieced inner border (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. b. Binding (6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.
SB20053-106	1/2 yard	Outer border (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 38 ½" from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Referring to quilt image for patch block placement guide, arrange and sew together (20) 2 ½" x 2 ½" print squares to make a pieced column. Make (2) pieced columns and sew to the left and right sides of trimmed 30 ½" x 40 ½" panel.



2. Arrange and sew together (17) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " print squares to make a pieced row. Make (2) pieced rows and sew to the top and bottom of panel.



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3. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border fabric strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border fabric strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.

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
