9" square finished

Sampler 107201, includes one fat quarter of each of the following fabrics. Yield per sampler approx. 5 blocks. Add a fat quarter of cream from your stash and make several more blocks. Mixing the two backgrounds in all of the blocks will add a scrappy look!

## TO MAKE ONE BLOCK

	107202 Gardening Tools, tan One 3-1/8" square COD
	107207 Flower Clusters, cream Six 3-1/8" squares COD
	107209 Berry Sprigs on Texture One 3-1/8" square COD
	107205 Squares in Squares One 5-3/4" square CTD
	107203 Flowers on Crosshatch One triangle using QST template
	107206 Leaf Clusters One triangle using QST template
	107204 Tiny Blossoms One triangle using QST template
	107208 Climbing Roses One triangle using QST template

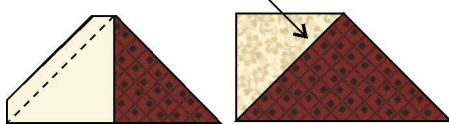
**COD = Cut once diagonally**

**CTD = Cut twice diagonally**

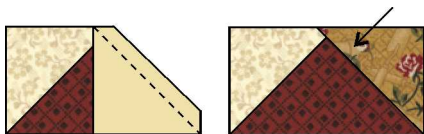
**QST = Quarter Square Triangle**

## DIRECTIONS

- 1- With right sides together, sew a small cream triangle the left side of a large red triangle. Press in the direction indicated by the arrow.



- 2- Sew another small tan triangle to the right side of the red triangle. Press.

- 3- Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the fabric combinations shown here.



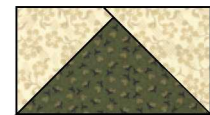

- 4- Sew the units steps 2 and 3 into pairs. Press.

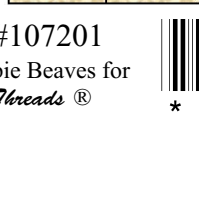


Make 1 of each.
