## 9" square finished

Sampler 107201, includes one fat quarter of each of the following fabrics. Yield per sampler approx. 5 blocks. Add a fat quarter of cream from your stash and make several more blocks. Mixing the two backgrounds in all of the blocks will add a scrappy look!

## COD = Cut once diagonally <br> HST $=$ Half Square Triangle

## DIRECTIONS

1- With right sides together, sew a small cream triangle the left side of a large red triangle. Press in the direction indicated by the arrow.


2- Sew another small tan triangle to the right side of the red triangle. Press.

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3- Repeat steps

1 and 2 for the fabric combinations shown here.

4- Sew the units steps 2 and 3 into pairs. Press.


Make 1 of each.
5- Sew the units from step 4 together. Press.

6- Sew the block halves together. Press final seam open.
